

Press release The Lucky Couple

Life began with a love song.

In 2004, Louie Lovechild (a.k.a. Jan Graber) and Holly Heartbreak (a.k.a. Alexandra Carambellas) founded the glam-pop-art-punk band The Lucky Couple.

The aim of this not entirely serious, but nonetheless glamorous art performance is to counter the gloom of the world with lightness, humor and a zest for life. And to show that a more mature age is by no means a reason to say goodbye to the world of the rock'n'roll lifestyle.

In addition to the music, the visual world of The Lucky Couple plays a central role: Louie Lovechild and Holly Heartbreak embody dazzling rock stars of the old school - Holly Heartbreak as seduction personified and Louie Lovechild with the greatest possible coolness.

They wrote numerous songs over the course of twenty years but did not release them for a long time. Until the duo found the opportunity during a break in 2023 to gather the pieces together, finish them and write more songs. Lovechild and Heartbreak subsequently recorded 13 songs on a Greek island under the simplest of conditions and with a minimal budget - songs that deal with love, loss and other absurdities of life.

The fact that the music sounds good despite the simple recording conditions is due not least to the mixing by Tommy Vetterli (New Sound Studio) and the mastering by Anna Murphy (Echochamber).

In January 2024 - around twenty years after their formation - the glam duo released their first single "Have Some Tea" and delivered an original, self-produced music video at the same time.

"Have Some Tea" was just the beginning. With "He Didn't Wait", "Do You Dance", "Virus" and "Perfect Ease of Mind", further tracks were released - always accompanied by a music or lyric video. More songs are in the quiver and will be fired over time as love arrows for the glamorous, yet humorously subtle lifestyle. Here's to making the world a brighter place.
